Course Description: We will trace the development of Oklahoma historically, culturally, economically, and politically. The diverse cultures that constitute the rich tradition of this state are part of the framework for studying the development of Indian Territory, Oklahoma Territory, and finally the state of Oklahoma. A study of the Sequoyah Convention, the Oklahoma Constitutional Convention and the Constitution itself lends a basic understanding of Oklahoma today. We will also look at the importance of having young people understand the role history plays in displaying God's sovereignty. We will be using the textbook *Oklahoma: The History of an American State* (ISBN 10: [1567330568](#)) as the foundation for note taking, however students will **not** be required to purchase this textbook.
